The Girls Open will run as a junior's competition and teams competing in this division will be exempt from nomination fees. The grade is open to all girls aged 18 and under and will be charged at \$45 per team per game.

Under 10's competition.

Baptist Basketball has received requests for a under 10's competition if we receive a minimum of 4 team nominations for both the under 10 and under 12 comp. then this grade will run if we do not then club reps will have the option for their under 10's to compete in the under 12's or to pull out. Under 10's will play at the 8am time slot.

All games will be played on Stadium Scoring, when possible, with club reps receiving player registration for teams by March 30 as well as the first 2 weeks' worth of fixtures.

Our mixed comp will run with both a social and competitive division with games scheduled from 8:50 to 12:10 depending on nominations

Season fixtures will be published by the end of April, Please note amendments to the season fixtures may occur after this date due to unforeseen circumstances.

Baptist Basketballs game rules have not changed this year, please feel free to download and read them from our website or to borrow a copy from the Ref desk.

All team fees need to be paid in cash prior to game start to the court controller.



All fines must be paid prior to teams next scheduled game either in cash or through completing a credit card authorisation.

All nomination fees must be paid by the end of the end of the third week. Payment can be made by cash, direct deposit or credit card authority. If full payment is made by the end of the first week teams receive a \$10 discount on nomination fees, if payment is received after the third week teams will be charged an additional \$20.

Nominations to be received by WABBA before the 17th March 2017 through email: contact@baptistbasketball.info or in person at our **nominations session**. Registration fees are \$180-Seniors & \$130-Juniors/Mixed a \$10 early bird discount is available if full payment is made before the 8th of April). Weekly Game fees are \$62-Seniors, \$52-Mixed & \$45-Juniors. Registration fees paid after 22nd of April and late nominations will be subject to a \$20 fee. The 2018 season will run from 7th of April with finals starting on 8th of September. Each church/school is to have one designated club rep & each nomination form to be signed by both Club Rep & the Church/Schools Pastor/Principal to indicate the acceptance of responsibility; including behavioral, financial & trustworthiness, for each team participating in the WABBA competition under their name, including the payments of any fines that may be imposed by WABBA, max 3x game fee (forfeit fine rates available from the court controller and website). All participants must be registered to their team online and club reps will be emailed team login codes and instructions for this to happen. All junior teams must be represented by a coach either having a child of their own present and playing on the team or holding a valid Working with Children Card (This is a legal requirement and the responsibility of club to observe). Junior WABL Player restrictions may apply.

Baptist Basketball is registered with kidsport™ and any child who is on a health care card or financial difficulty is encouraged to claim their seasons fee's directly from their local government, WABBA can help you with this, please email us for more info contact@baptistbasketball.info. All teams must be in matching uniform incl. shorts, before the game can begin failure to be in uniform will be resulted as an un-notified forfeit, however singlets can be hired on the day for \$15 per set and shorts for \$3 per pair.
